❖ **SELECTION PROCESS:**



The candidates for MPPSC ADPO Recruitment will be selected through the 2 stages. The stages are:

- Mains Examination → **Written Exam**
- Viva-Voce → **Personal Interview**

MPPSC ADPO Exam Pattern:

Candidates enrolling for the **MPPSC ADPO** Recruitment must understand the detailed exam pattern for **Written exam**. **The Written exam will be 450 marks and Interview will be 50 marks.**
