SYLLABUS OF CUET

- The CUET or Common University Entrance Test is a common entrance exam that is conducted by NTA for UG Admissions across 90+ Universities, including all the Central Universities in India. A total of 45 Central Universities (with the likes of, DU, JNU, Hyderabad University, and Allahabad University) will be taking admissions in UG courses based on the CUET 2023 score. Some important details about the CUET Exam are mentioned in the table below:
- The CUET will be held online as a computer-based test (CBT) and in two shifts, Slot I (morning) & Slot II (afternoon). The duration of the exam will be 3 Hours 15 minutes & 3 Hours 45 minutes respectively, depending on the subject combination chosen by the students. A candidate has to write one or more exams in both slots.
- One of the most important things to help you with your CUET Exam Preparation is balancing your studies. One can not be preferred over the other. You should thoroughly understand the CUET 2023 Exam Pattern and prepare simultaneously for Boards + CUET 2023.
