CLAT ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

***** MINIMUM EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

- ➤ Candidates should have a graduate/post graduate degree from the University of Delhi, or any Indian/Foreign university recognized by DU.
- > Candidates who are on the rolls of the LLB programme or exstudents of any university will not be eligible for the admission. (They have to cancel their current admission before applying for DU LLB)
- > Candidates appearing in the qualifying degree examination will be eligible to take DU LLB. However, they will have to produce required documents at the time of the admission.
- > The qualifying marks for the candidates belonging to the unreserved **category is 50% marks** or equivalent grade point in the qualifying examination.
- > Candidates **belonging to OBC/CW/PwD category** should obtain at least **45**% **marks and SC/ST candidates should obtain 40**% **marks** in the qualifying examination.
- > However, rounding of a fraction will not be allowed, i.e. **44.6**% **will not be considered as 45**%

❖ SYLLABUS FOR DU/LLB

The test paper of DU LLB entrance exam will have 4 sections as mentioned below.

- 1. Analytical abilities
- 2. General knowledge
- 3. English language comprehension
- 4. Legal awareness and aptitude

❖ DU LLB EXAM PATTERN:

- Exam duration- 120 minutes
- Exam mode- Online (CBT)
- Language English
- Type of Question-Multiple- choice Type Questions
- Total Marks-400
- Number Of Questions- 100
- Marking scheme- For each correct answer 4 marks will be awarded and there will be a deduction of 1 mark for each wrong answer.

❖ ANALYTICAL ABILITIES

The questions in this section primarily test the logical thinking ability of the candidates. It includes important topics such as:

- logical reasoning, analytical reasoning,
- number system,
- percentage and average and others.

❖ ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMPREHENSION

In this section the questions will be from topics like:

- sentence and word correction,
- antonyms and synonyms,
- grammar,

and comprehension and more. This section in DU LLB syllabus tests the fundamental knowledge of the candidates in grammar, vocabulary and reading and writing skills..

❖ GENERAL KNOWLEDGE

General knowledge section assesses candidates' knowledge on the latest developments across the globe. The questions will be based on :

- current news and also from static GK,
- history,
- geography,
- politics,
- economics and environmental science.

❖ <u>LEGAL AWARENESS AND APTITUDE</u>



It is one of the most important sections in DU LLB syllabus. The questions asked in this section will be mainly about:

- legal GK,
- Constitution of India,
- different acts and others.

It tests the legal knowledge and problem-solving skills of the candidates.
