- > Age limit- not more than 35 years (For SC/ST 5 year Relaxation)
- > Candidate must have completed 3 years as a practising advocate

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Preliminary Examination -> Objective Type- multiple choice questions.
- Mains Examination -> Narrative or Essay Type
- Viva-Voce → Personal Interview
- Exam Pattern- The Examination Pattern will be as follows:

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

- THE EXAM IS OF OBJECTIVE TYPE IT CONSISTS OF MULTIPLE-CHOICE QUESTION.
 - The screening test will be a computer-based test and the questions asked in this stage will be Multiple choice types. (100 marks 2 hours)
 - > The language of the questions asked will be English.
 - > There will be no negative marking in the screening test.
