SCHEME AND SYLLABUS

- ❖ **Haryana Judicial Services Exam Eligibility Criteria:**
 - Applicants must have completed **LL.B** from any recognized institute.
 - The age Limit- **21 years and must not be more than 42 years.** (for SC/ST/OBC - 5 years relaxation)
- ❖ **SELECTION PROCESS:**
 - Preliminary Examination (**Objective Type**)
 - Written Main Examination (**Subjective Type**)
 - Viva-Voce (**Personal Interview**)
- ❖ **Exam Pattern:** The Examination Pattern will be as follows:

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION(400 Marks)

- The Exam will be Objective Type.
- The time Duration for the Examination will be 2 Hours.
- The Exam will be of **125 Questions** and each question carry 4 marks and for every wrong question **0.20** i.e., 1/5 marks shall be deducted.
- There will, however, be no negative marking in respect of un-attempted questions.
- No candidate shall be allowed to appear in the Main Examination unless he/she secured minimum 150 marks (read 100 marks for all reserved category candidates) in the Preliminary Examination.

SUBJECT FOR PRELIMINARY EXAM

- All law subjects of Mains Examination.
- Current events of National and International importance,
- Indian legal and Constitutional history and governance.
- Analytical skills, Reasoning and aptitude

MAINS EXAMINATION (900 Marks)

❖ **Main Examination will be subjective/narrative type.**

- Exam will be conducted in English Medium except for language paper.
- Copy of Bare Acts of legislative enactments shall be supplied.
- Each written paper shall be of three hours duration.
