SCHEME AND SYLLABUS

- **Haryana Judicial Services Exam Eligibility Criteria:**
 - ➤ Applicants must have completed **LL.B** from any recognized institute.
 - ➤ The age Limit- 21 years and must not be more than 42 years. (for SC/ST/OBC 5 years relaxation)

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Preliminary Examination (Objective Type)
- Written Main Examination (Subjective Type)
- Viva-Voce (**Personal Interview**)
- **Exam Pattern**: The Examination Pattern will be as follows:

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION(400 Marks)

- ➤ The Exam will be Objective Type.
- ➤ The time Duration for the Examination will be 2 Hours.
- ➤ The Exam will be of **125 Questions** and each question carry 4 marks and for every wrong question **0.20** i.e., 1/5 marks shall be deducted.
- ➤ There will, however, be no negative marking in respect of un-attempted questions.
- ➤ No candidate shall be allowed to appear in the Main Examination unless he/she secured minimum 150 marks (read 100 marks for all reserved category candidates) in the Preliminary Examination.
