### **SCHEME AND SYLLABUS**

- ❖ **Jharkhand Judicial Services Exam Eligibility Criteria:**
  - Applicants must have completed **LL.B** from any recognized institute.
  - The age Limit-**22 - 35 year** (in case of female candidates belonging to **SC/ST** / there shall be **relaxation of upper age limit by 3 years** )
  - The candidate should also be enrolled as an **advocate** via the **Advocates, Act, 1961** until the last date of submission of the application form. Also, they should have done valid and active applications and registration to appear for the exam.

  - Preliminary Examination → **Objective Type**
  - Mains Examination → **subjective Types**
  - Viva-Voce → **Personal Interview**
  - **Exam Pattern-** The Examination Pattern will be as follows:

### **PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION**

- ❖ **THE EXAM IS OF OBJECTIVE TYPE IT CONSISTS OF MULTIPLE-CHOICE QUESTION.**
  - The time Duration for the Examination will be 2 Hours.
  - The Exam shall be of 100 marks in aggregate.
  - There shall be no negative marking.

### **VIVA- VOCE (INTERVIEW)**

- ❖ It will carry **100 marks**. However minimum qualifying marks required to be secured would be **25% for general category candidates and 20 % for SC/ST/OBC**
