#### **❖** Jharkhand Judicial Services Exam Eligibility Criteria:

- > Applicants must have completed **LL.B** from any recognized institute.
- > The age Limit-22 35 year (in case of female candidates belonging to SC/ST / there shall be relaxation of upper age limit by 3 years)
- ➤ The candidate **should also be enrolled as an advocate via the**Advocates, Act, 1961 until the last date of submission of the application form. Also, they should have done valid and active applications and registration to appear for the exam.
