- **❖** Karnataka Judicial Services Exam Eligibility Criteria:
 - ➤ Applicants must have completed **LL.B** from any recognized institute.
 - ➤ The SC or ST applicants must be of 38 years of age.
 - ➤ For the unreserved candidates, the age limit is 35 years of age.

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Preliminary Examination Objective Type- multiple choice questions.
- Mains Examination → written type.
- Viva-Voce → Personal Interview
- Negative marking of 0.25 will be deducted in the prelim's examination.

MAINS EXAM SYLLABUS

Syllabus prescribed for main written examination.

- ➤ The main examination will be conducted in three papers.
- ➤ Each paper comprises 150 Questions. One paper in Civil Law & another paper in Criminal Law will be conducted.
- > mains exam will be conducted the exam in **4 papers of 100 marks** each.
