- ❖ **Rajasthan Judicial Services Exam Eligibility Criteria:**
 - Applicants must have completed **LL.B** from any recognized institute.
 - The age Limit-not be more than **35 years**. (For **SC/ST /OBC- 5 years relaxation**)
 - You must have a thorough knowledge of Hindi written in Devanagari Script and Rajasthani dialects and the social customs of Rajasthan.
- ❖ **SELECTION PROCESS:**
 - Preliminary Examination → **Objective Type**
 - Mains Examination → **subjective Types**
 - Viva-Voce → **Personal Interview**
 - **Exam Pattern-** The Examination Pattern will be as follows:

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

- ❖ **The Exam will be Objective Type.**
 - The Exam will be of- 100 Marks/ Questions.
 - The time Duration for the Examination will be- 02 Hours.
 - There will be no Negative Marking.

Note:→ The Preliminary Examination shall be an objective type examination in which 70% weightage will be given to the subjects prescribed in syllabus for Law Papers-I and II, and 30% weightage shall be given to test proficiency in Hindi and English language. The marks obtained in the preliminary examination shall not be counted towards the final selection.
