- **U.P Judicial Services Exam Eligibility Criteria:**
 - ➤ Applicants must have completed **LL.B** from any recognized institute.
 - ➤ The age Limit- 22 years and must not be more than 35 years. (for SC/ST/OBC 5 years relaxation)
 - ➤ An Advocate enrolled under the provisions of the Advocates Act 1961 or a Barrister of England or Northern Ireland or a member of the Advocates in Scotland and entitled to practice in the Court or Courts subordinate thereto.
 - Must have complete knowledge of Hindi in Devanagari script

SELECTION PROCESS:

- Preliminary Examination (Objective Type)
- Mains Exam- Descriptive Exam
- Viva-Voce (Personal Interview)
- Exam Pattern: The Examination Pattern will be as follows:

PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION

- ➤ The Exam is of Objective type
- ➤ It consists of Multiple-Choice Questions.
- ➤ Question paper comprises of 2 papers.
- ➤ Duration of each paper is 2 Hours.
- > Paper 1 consists of General knowledge for 150 marks
- ➤ Paper 2 consists of Law subject for 300 marks
- ➤ There will be 1 Mark for right answer and 0.33 negative marking for each wrong answer

The suitability of candidates for employment in the Uttar Pradesh Judicial Service will be tested with reference to his merit giving due regard to his ability character, personality and physique. The marks obtained in interview round will be added to the Marks scored in the written mains exam. Merit list will be made on the basis of their marks obtained in both exams.

The candidates will have a choice to answer General Knowledge and Law papers either in Hindi or in English.

Note: (i) The marks obtained in the interview will be added to the Marks obtained in the written papers and the candidates place will depend on the aggregate of both
